

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GREY HIGHLANDS

BY-LAW NUMBER 2010 - 08

Being a By-law to establish 2010 Water and Wastewater rates for the Municipality of Grey Highlands and to repeal By-law 2009-112

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Municipality of Grey Highlands operates and maintains municipal water and sewer systems in the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, states that a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges for services provided, such as water and wastewater services.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GREY HIGHLANDS HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Section 391, water and wastewater rates are hereby charged upon all the owners who use water and wastewater services or occupants of land, and these rates are outlined within Schedule "A" to By-law 2010 - 08, which forms a part of this by-law.
2. Schedule "B", which forms a part of this by-law, outlines the equivalency to dwelling units.
3. This by-law shall come into effect on the final date of passing. By-law 2009-112 and all former by-laws inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.


Read a first and second time this 8th day of February 2010.

SCHEDULE "B" OF BY-LAW 2010 - 08

Wastewater Units

Flesherton Wastewater

Units Other Than Dwelling Units	Equivalency to Dwelling Unit
Bed & Breakfast per wc	1/4
Artists/Artisans Studios; Auto Body/Repair Shops; Churches; Library; Manufacturing (existing 1995); Museum; Offices; Organization Meeting Halls; Stores; Shops	1/2
Firehall; Public Washrooms; Service Stations; Banks; Day Care Centres	1
Auto Body/Repair Shops with clean-up bay; Beauty Salons	1 1/2
Restaurants, Bars; Service Station with clean-up bay	2
School	15

A building or complex of buildings with a combination of uses will be charged the aggregate total of the applicable rates.

** Future users or potential users not specified shall have the equivalency to dwelling unit established by resolution by the Council who shall have regard to the existing rates as a basis to arrive at a fair and equitable charge.

Amik Wastewater System

1 sewage unit = 1 housing unit of 1.35 m³ per day (297 imp. gal. per day)

Kimberley-Amik-Talisman Water System

1 water unit = 1.4 m³ per average day not to exceed 4.2 m³ per maximum day
