- Conserve energy and minimize water consumption.
- Be considerate of your neighbours – please no excessive noise or disturbances at any time.
- Actively participate in waste diversion programs including sorting waste and supporting our 'Leave No Trace' initiative in our naturalized environments.
- Actively participate in our community and discover the wonders of Grey Highlands.
- No smoking or vaping in buildings (some distance restrictions may apply).
- Clean up after your pet on all private and public properties.
- Fireworks are not permitted.
