Consolidated By-law No. 2020-034

A By-law to Prohibit Heavy Trucks on specific Highways in Grey Highlands

Office Consolidation of By-law 2020-034 and By-law 2023-125 (Replacement of Schedule A)

Whereas, Section 8 of the Municipal Act 2001, R.S.O. 2001, as amended provides that a municipality has the authority to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and enables the municipality to respond to municipal issues; and

Whereas, Section 5(3) of the Municipal Act 2001, R.S.O. 2001, as amended provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

Whereas, Section 27 of the Municipal Act 2001, R.S.O. 2001, as amended provides that a municipality may pass by-laws in respect of a highway only if it has jurisdiction over the highway; and

Whereas, Section 28(1) of the Municipal Act 2001, R.S.O. 2001, as amended sets out the highways over which a municipality has jurisdiction; and

Whereas, Section 35 of the Municipal Act 2001, R.S.O. 2001, as amended provides that a municipality may pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway; and

Whereas, it is deemed necessary and desirable that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Grey Highlands enact a by-law authorizing the Corporation to enact heavy truck restrictions on certain highways within the municipality; and

Whereas, the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Grey Highlands deems it necessary to repeal By-Law No. 2012-73 upon the passage of this by-law;

Now Therefore the Council of the Municipality of Grey Highlands hereby enacts as follows:

1. **Definitions**

- a. "Director" shall mean the Director of Transportation and Environmental Services of the Municipality of Grey Highlands or his/her designate.
- b. "Heavy Truck" is defined as any commercial vehicle having a registered gross weight greater than 4,500 kilograms but does not include ambulances or fire trucks.
- c. "Highway" includes a common or public highway, street, avenue, parkway, drive, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, any part of which is intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes the area between the lateral property lines thereof, which is owned by the Municipality of Grey Highlands.

- d. "Person" includes an individual and/or a Corporation.
- e. "Sign" means a sign as described as "No Heavy Trucks" sign RB-62 in the Ontario Traffic Manual, pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

2. Prohibitions

- a. Where signage has been erected and is on display, no person shall drive, move, operate or park "Heavy Trucks" upon or over any of the highways or parts of highways named or described in Schedule "A" of this By-law.
- b. No person shall hinder or obstruct, or attempt to hinder or obstruct, any person who is exercising a power or performing a duty under this By-law.

3. Exemptions

- a. The provisions of this by-law shall not extend to the use of the said highway or parts of highways for deliveries to or removals from any premise abutting thereon.
- b. The provisions of this by-law shall not apply to emergency service vehicles, to public utility vehicles, or to waste management vehicles while engaged in picking up waste and/or recycling from premises abutting thereon.
- c. The provisions of this by-law shall not extend to the Municipality of Grey Highlands staff, the County of Grey staff or their agents and contractors in performing municipal work.

4. Enforcement

a. This By-law may be enforced by an Ontario Provincial Police Officer, Ministry of Transportation Officer or Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

5. Offence

a. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 33, as amended.

6. **Designated Authority**

a. The Director of Transportation and Environmental Services and/or designate is hereby authorized to erect, or cause to be erected, the necessary signs in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act.

7. Severability

a. If a court of competent jurisdiction declares any provision, or any part of a provision, of this by-law to be invalid, or to be of no force and effect, it is the intention of Council in enacting this by-law that each and every provision of this by-law authorized by law be applied and enforced in accordance with its terms to the extent possible according to law.

8. Force and Effect

- a. That By-law No. 2012-73 of the Corporation of the Municipality of Grey Highlands is hereby repealed.
- b. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of final passage hereof at which time all by-laws and/or resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this bylaw and the same are hereby repealed or rescinded insofar as it is necessary to give effect to the provisions of this bylaw.
- c. That Schedule A attached hereto is hereby declared to form part of this by-law; and

d. That Schedule B in substantially the same for as attached hereto is hereby declared to form part of this by-law once approved by the Chief Justice or the Regional Senior Justice.

9. Short Title

a. This by-law may be referred to as the "Heavy Truck Restriction By-law".

Read a first, second and third time, and finally passed on April 15 2020.
